

NYSLAA will award one (or more) scholarship(s) per conference.

This Scholarship is named after a long time NYSLAA member who loved attending the annual conference. Eileen Lemley passed away during the 2014 conference. This award, previously called the NYSLAA Conference Contest, was renamed in her honor in hopes of helping another member achieve the same appreciation for the annual conferences as Eileen had.

To qualify for the Eileen Lemley Conference Scholarship (ELSC), you must:

- ✤ Be a current regular member of NYSLAA
- Be a NYSLAA member for the previous consecutive three years
- * NOT receive any conference funding from your institution

To apply for a scholarship submit the following to the NYSLAA President:

- The completed application form below
- A written statement of 150 to 300 words explaining:
 "What NYSLAA means to me and why I would love to attend the conference."
- ✤ A letter from the NYSLAA Membership Secretary verifying your years of membership.

Please note:

- Applications will be accepted between March 1^{st} and March 31^{st} .
- The award will cover full conference registration, the mixer, up to two nights lodging in the conference designated venue, and your choice of one tour.
- This does not cover apparel.
- First consideration will be given to those applicants who have not received the ELCS scholarship previously.
- Scholarships will be awarded for the upcoming June conference.
