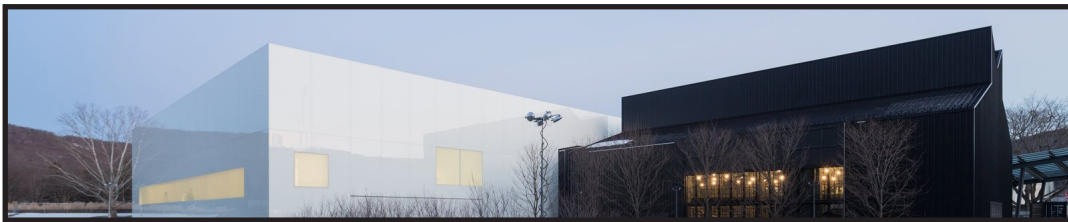

Founded in 1951 by Corning Glass Works (now Corning Incorporated) The Corning Museum of Glass is a not-for-profit museum dedicated to telling the story of a single material: glass. When you visit, you'll see more than 3,500 years of history displayed, from the glass portrait of an ancient Egyptian pharaoh to contemporary sculpture made in glass. <https://www.cmog.org>

Meet at the registration table at 12:30. Tour group leaves promptly at 12:35 p.m.

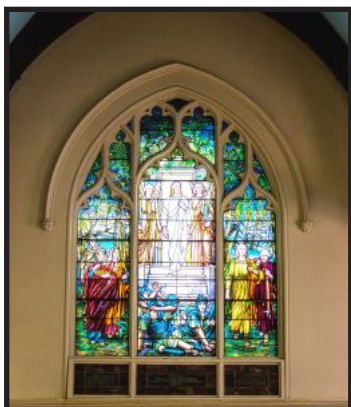

Christ Episcopal Church

The architectural style of the 400-seat Christ Church is early English Gothic, and is representative of many similar churches built across New York State in the last half of the 19th century. The tower bell, cast in 1871 at Troy, NY, was salvaged from the fire at our original church and continues to toll faithfully every Sunday even after a century of service. Integral to Christ Church's aesthetic beauty are the nearly 85 stained glass windows that adorn the sanctuary. Most of the older ones were produced by the Tiffany Glass and Decorating Company, and by J. & R. Lamb Studios. <https://www.christepiscopalcorning.org/>
